

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
PEOPLES INSTITUTE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, Mrs Helen Ladd Corbett, Mrs A. E. Rockey, Mrs H. C. Cabell and Mrs George Whiteside Trustees of the Peoples Institute of Portland, Oregon, a religious charitable and educational society being hereunto duly authorized by the Board of Trustees thereof, duly chosen in accordance with the usage and regulations of said society, do hereby adopt the following articles of incorporation for said Peoples Institute to wit:

I The name assumed by said society and by which it shall be known is the Peoples Institute

II THE DURATION of this Corporation shall be perpetual.

III The object, business and pursuit of this Corporation is to establish and support Social Settlement work among the women and children within its reach, offering them educational, industrial, medical, social, religious and friendly aid and to accept and receive, own and control bequests, donations and gifts of money or property real or personal to be held and used or applied to the purposes of said society and to lease, own, hold and control all such property real or personal as may be necessary or convenient to enable it to carry out the purpose, object, business and pursuit thereof as hereinbefore defined.

IV The estimated value of property and money possessed by said society is \$2100.00 and the sources of revenue are from voluntary contributions, gifts, bequests, donations and membership dues and contributions.

V The title of the Trustees making these articles and their Post Office addresses are as follows: Mrs Helen Ladd Corbett, 293 Sixth St, Mrs A. E. Rockey, Oswego, Mrs H. C. Cabell, 225 King Street, Mrs George Whiteside, Douglas Place and the modes and times of the election of their successors is by the Board of Trustees at the Annual Meeting thereof held the first Friday in February in each year.

VI The location of said Peoples Institute is at the City of Portland, Multnomah County, State of Oregon.
