My dear Miss Pritchard,

Certainly your letter and reports were very much appreciated by me and I hope some-day to have time to stop and see you.

Just now I wish to write concerning a patient, a little girl. I think she is about 12 yrs. of age.

When a very small child the Suisons fell into I.R. eye. - penetrating it and causing adhesion of the iris at one point.

I saw her when 6 yrs. of age ¹⁹²³ and gave her glasses, and she got along nicely, if she wore the glasses. In Apr. of 1929 she came again having had glasses changed else-where, several

times, finally the optician decided there was some thing wrong with her eye and sent her here. I saw what appeared to be a cyst of the iris at the point of trauma and decided to watch it and see if it developed.

She required some muscle exercises and then did not come again until Apr. 10th 1930.

At this time the cyst was very much larger and I became suspicious of what it might be a tubercle instead of a cyst. Her father is in the Eastern Oregon. I. B. Hosp.

I sent her to the Hosp. for exam, and received report of Active I. B. in chest.

Dr. Payne, the resident-physician, and I have talked the matter over. There is no room for her here in the Hosp. and it is difficult as well as entailing much extra work on his part to carry out the Tuberculin treatment - in the home.

I am very anxious she have it as soon as possible. We hoped she might be admitted to the Donahues

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Hospital and Dr. Payne thought the
entrance might be facilitated to
pass her through your clinic.

I do not know who has this
clinic so am sending this to
you and hope Dr. Bissell may
see the case.

I am enclosing Dr. Payne's report
and you may pass these both
on to the proper party.

If she cannot get into the Doane
Becher hospital Dr. Payne will try to
carry out the treatment in her home, for
he is very much interested in the case.
Her brother has congenital cataracts
and the county nurse may take
them both in to the ~~hosp~~ clinic.
Our county nurse is Miss Marian
Lund. Thanking you for the assistance
I can depend upon from you I am
