Dear Miss Prichard:

I desire to call to your attention the fact that, upon recommendation of the Medical School, the Board of Regents of the University has appointed Miss Grace Phelps, Superintendent of the Doernbecher Hospital, to the position of Director of Nursing of the University of Oregon Medical School. This is done in order to centralize supervision of the nursing establishment in the various departments of the Medical School and in order to enable a contemplated plan looking to the development of a University School of Nursing.

Henceforth, therefore, all nurses employed by the Medical School will be under the direction of Miss Phelps and the employment or dismissal of nursing personnel shall be subject to her approval exclusively, excepting in such instances as she shall desire to delegate such authority.
