Fourtenn families were provided for at Christmas.

Mrs McOmber is back after a six weeks absence owing to an accident by which she broke her leg.

The work of the Dispensary is largest since its inauguration, eleven years ago. The Annual report shows the total number of patients for the year, 7063-----Number treatments given- 9654.

The rent for the rooms at 4th. & Jefferson Sts. has been raised from \$50 to \$75 per month. The City and County have both given slight increase

increase in their appropriations to meet the increased expenses this year.

The Statistical report followed.

The Financial report was read and approved.
