Minutes of Board Meeting Sept. 16, 1921

The regular monthly meeting of the People's Institute was held Sept. 16, 1921, at the office at 4th & Jefferson Sts. There were present Mrs. Corbett, Mrs. Ayer, Mrs. Shevlin, Mrs. Whiteside, Mrs. Rockey, Mrs. Johnson, Mrs. Grelle and Miss Prichard. Minutes of last meeting were read and approved. The Treasurer's report was read and approved. \$888.73 was reported as the balance in the bank Sept. 1. Mrs. Corbett reported that Mr. Holman of the County Commissioners had promised to mail us a check for \$900.00 within a few days. Director's Report was read and approved.

It is planned to enlarge the quarters and increase the scope of the work. A well baby clinic will be one of the features of the expanded work. Our lease is up and we will have to renew it at an increase of \$25.00. Also are renting a large store room on Jefferson Street at \$50.00. Our total rent will then be \$175.00. The Medical School has promised to help with the increased rent.

It was reported that we have received only \$300.00 of the \$1,000 allowed us by the Community Chest.A committee consisting of Mrs. Ayer, Mrs. Rockey, Mrs. Whiteside and Miss Prichard was appointed by Mrs. Corbett to go before the Community Chest asking that we be allowed to send out the notices of our yearly dues, partly in order to increase our income and partly to retain the interest of our membership.

It was proposed and approved by the Board that Miss Prichard from now on give her entire time to the work of the Dispensary. Miss Prichard reported that she had confided the work of the other departments to competent committees. It was moved and approved to lease the additional store rooms for the use of the Dispensary. Preparations for this increase had been made during the Summer', to help with the increased rent. The meeting then adjourned.
