The regular meeting of the Peoples Institute and Portland Free Dispensary was held on Friday, Dec. 10, 1921, Mrs. Corbett in the chair. Those present were Mrs. W. B. Ayer, Mrs. A. E. Rockey, Mrs. Victor Johnson, Mrs. C. E. Grelle, Mrs. E. C. Shevlin. The minutes of the preceeding meeting were read. A correction was made in regard to the consultation Mrs. Ayer, Mrs. Rockey, Mrs. Whiteside and Miss Prichard had with the Community Chest Committee about our budget for the year. The report was then approved.

Treasurer's report was read and approved.

The Director's report was read and approved. She reported the Dispendary as running with unusually full numbers, and the doctors more regular in their attentance than ever before.

The Statistical report of the Dispensary was read and approved.

Miss. Prichard reported that Mr. Griffith said he would give us one book of car tickets a month for the use of Mrs. Davis in her work, and would take under consideration the reduction of our electric light rate.

A suggestion was made that a campaign be made to obtain new members, but the consensus of opinion of the Board seemed to be that we rely for this year upon the Community Chest - to find out definitely if the Chest plan is successful, and in no way to hamper it.

The meeting then adjourned.
