A called meeting of the Peoples' Institute and Free Dispensary was held November 14, 1922, at 10:30 at the office on Fourth and Jefferson Streets.

Present, Mrs. Corbett, Mrs. Wilcox, Mrs. Allen Lewis, Mrs. Gillison, Mrs. Johnson, Mrs. C. Hunt Lewis, Mrs. Grelle and Miss Prichard. Mrs. Corbett read a letter from Campaign Advisory Committee of the Community Chest asking for our co-operation in the coming drive for funds and for our list of Directors and Members- Mrs. Corbett asked for volunteers. Mrs. Johnson agreed to take the chairmanship of the Institute Campaign Workers. Mrs. Lewis and Mrs. Grelle volunteered as Solicitors. Miss Prichard reported that the Chest had cut down our 1922 allotment by 12½% which will leave us about \$700. behind.

We have asked for \$7000. for 1923, an increase of \$1100. more than last year, but the Chest has told us they could give us no more than \$5,900, the same amount they promised us for 1922, and that amount depends upon their success in collecting the estimated necessary funds. It was decided to give a card party at Mrs. Wilcox's home, Glenwood, to raise money to meet partially the estimated deficit of the year. Mrs. Hunt Lewis, Mrs. Gillison and Mrs. Grelle offered to take charge of the arrangements for the card party.

The meeting then adjourned.
