The regular monthly meeting of the Peoples Institute was held Friday, March 2nd, 1923, at the office, Fourth and Jefferson Streets.- Present, Mrs. Corbett, Mrs. Kerr, Mrs. Devereaux, Mrs. Thompson, Mrs. Grelle, Mrs. Lewis, Mrs. Wight, Mrs. Gillison, Mrs. Johnson and Miss Prichard. This meeting, besides being a regular monthly meeting was practically our regular annual meeting, which had been postponed. 224

The Treasurer's report was readby Mrs. Johnson and approved as read.

The Director's report for the year was read by Miss Prichard. The growth of the work in the past year was reported as greater than in any previous year. The Orthopedic Clinic, inaugurated the first of the year under the Junior League, was reported as progressing very satisfactorily. Two additional workers on the staff were reported, - Miss Cecil Schreyer as Supervising Nurse, and Mrs. Arestine Felts as Social Service Secretary, also the services of a volunteer worker, a trained nurse, Miss Starkwæther, who has given her time for several months. The need of a trained pharmacist was once again emphasized. Various other needs of the Institute in the respect of additional workers in the different departments, a typist, use of an automobile for the Social Service Visitor when she has long distances to cover. The Director reported having made the following recommendations to the Joint Dispensary Committee:

 The employment of Miss Starkweather as additional nurse and also as assistant to the Registrar by the Medical School.
 That the matter of a pharmacist, laboratory technician, etc. be taken care of by the Budget which the Medical School is to arrange.

(3) Also that extra room, further equipment, etc. be arranged by this budget.

(4) That we look to the State Health Board to provide a secretary or Clerk as well as visitor for the Venereal Clinic.
(5) The employment of a typist on at least half time by the Peoples Institute.

(6) That the members of the Institute try to provide automobile service at various times.

Miss Prichard suggested that we apply to the County for an appropriation such as we formerly received from the County.

The Director's report was approved as read.

Mrs. Gillison gave the report of the Legislative Committee, which was approved as read.
