Sirs:

The Public Health Service is sending under separate cover one set ~~each~~ of pamphlets A, B, C, D, F, as requested by you on March 3. Pamphlet "E", for girls, is out of print and cannot be sent you at present.

Your State Board of Health, in cooperation with the United States Public Health Service, is giving special attention to this campaign against venereal diseases.
