Enclosed please find the information regarding clinic days and hours of the portland Free Dispensary wwhich you requested.

This information was attached on seperate slip on the last report as there is no place indicated on report blanks for this particular kind of information.

I wish to call your attention to the fact that although you stated in a former letter that the Portland Free Dispensary was a subsidiary of the Chamberlain-Kahn fund, we have never received any financial aid from that source.

WE have taken the matter up with the City Health Bureau and with the State Health Board, but up to the present timethere have been no tagible results.

We need a fund of at least \$ 400. a year to aid the venereal patients who cannot afford to pay for their treatments .

If you can assist us in this matter weshall greatly appreciate your interest .
